Green Wall at Sydney's Marriott Hotel

“Moving Hyde Park to the port-cochere”, was how Sara Blackley, head of design at Intermain, described the recently completed lush dense wall of green along the Marriott's entry along College Street in Sydney.

The brief from Mirvac Investment Management was to open-up and modernise the area in line with Mirvac's sustainability strategy. This was achieved by dressing the exterior marble entrance with a dark charcoal concrete finish, 'Pandomo', providing a flowing wet sheen. The façade of the exterior bulkhead was painted in darker hues to align with the entrance, enhancing the nickel against darker monochromatic tones to create a more urbane logo. The installation of a self-sustaining 3 x 10mt living wall, brings colour and life and extends the living lushness of neighbouring Hyde Park.

“The process has been a true collaboration of design, innovation and technology”, explains Intermain designer Katie Burt, “requiring experts in lighting, as well as horticulture and reticulated irrigation, to complement the design team's vision”.

Intermain was responsible for the design, project management and construction, engaging Fytogreen (Victoria) on horticultural elements, Point-of-View electrical engineers for light distribution, and Concrete Artisans for specialised rendering.
